



## MONTGOMERY DAY ONE JOURNEY

- 10:00am Meet Etgar 36 Staff at Court Square Fountain  
(Central Time) *Begin the journey at the bus stop where Rosa Parks boarded for her historic journey, just steps away from Dexter Ave Baptist Church where Dr. King preached. Learn about the cultural changes in America that led to the budding Civil Rights movement in Montgomery.*
- 11:00am Tour the Rosa Parks Museum  
*Built on the very spot where Rosa Parks was arrested on December 1<sup>st</sup> 1955, this museum traces the evolution of the Montgomery Improvement Association into the larger Civil Rights Movement.*
- 12:00pm Visit Montgomery's Selma Mural  
*Explore the groundbreaking event that directly led to the passage of the Voting Rights Bill. Learn about how the small town of Selma became a national focus, the three historic marches, and the work of the young John Lewis.*
- 12:30pm Lunch on your own in Downtown Montgomery
- 1:45pm Meet outside EJI's Legacy Museum  
*Etgar 36 staff will explain the work of the Bryan Stevenson's Equal Justice Initiative (EJI) and the new historical perspective presented by their museum.*
- 2:00pm Tour EJI Legacy Museum  
*Tour this modern museum, tracing the evolution of racism from slavery to mass incarceration.*
- 3:30pm Meet outside museum to drive up to the Memorial  
*Make connections to our own story by learning about the lynching of Leo Frank in Atlanta. Contemplate modern tragedies and the interconnectedness of our lives.*
- 4:00pm Explore the National Memorial of Peace and Justice, honoring victims of domestic racial terror lynchings.
- 5:00pm ONE DAY TRIP: End of Journey.
