*Visit the headquarters of the Selma Civil Rights movement. Hear the full story of Selma's history from the tragic death of a young activist to the historic marches that began from the steps of this church.*
- 11:45 am Visit the James Reeb Memorial  
*Learn about the murder of James Reeb and discuss the role and importance of allies in a movement.*
- 12:15 pm Walk across the Edmund Pettis Bridge  
*Walk in the footsteps of heroes across the bridge made infamous by Bloody Sunday.*
- 12:30 pm Selma Memorial Park  
*Pay respects to martyrs of the movement, and learn some of the lesser known names from the Selma movement, including the leading female activists.*
