- Explore this historic center of town where Rosa Parks boarded the bus for her famous ride, visible from the Capital building and Dexter Ave Baptist Church.
- 11:00 am Rosa Parks Historical Marker**
- Stand where the Civil Rights movement began and learn about the Montgomery Bus Boycott.
- 11:15 am Selma to Montgomery Mural**
- Learn about major actions of the Civil Rights Movement, including the lunch counter sit-ins, the Freedom Rides, and the March on Washington.
- 11:30 am Lunch on own in Downtown Montgomery**
- 1:00 pm Equal Justice Initiative's Legacy Offices**
- Discuss the evolution of oppression from slavery to mass incarceration and the creation of a narrative of racial difference.
- 1:45 pm Southern Poverty Law Center Civil Rights Memorial**
- Learn about the work that the Southern Poverty Law Center does tracking and fighting hate groups. See the moving exhibit designed by Maya Lin honoring 40 martyrs and events of the Civil Rights movement.
- 2:30 pm Outdoor Freedom Rider Exhibit**
- See the faces of the heroic activists, hear the story of the violence they faced, and stand in the place where it happened.
